**Conference** The conference will be held at Aula Magna, Stockholm University, Frescativägen 6, starting Friday, January 30 at 10:00 AM, and ending Saturday, January 31 at 3:00 PM. To get to Aula Magna, take the metro (subway) to Universitetet station, about 10 minutes from Stockholm Central Station. Registration opens at 9:30 AM on Friday at the registration desk in Aula Magna, where you will receive your name badge.

**Meals** During your stay at Aula Magna: Lunch will be served at Lantis, located around the corner. Coffee breaks (fika) will be served on the same floor as the exhibitors, in Aula Magna.

**Dinner for speakers and organizers** will take place on Friday, January 30, 2026, at 6:30 PM at Ulla Winbladh, Djurgården, Rosendalsvägen 8, 115 21 Stockholm.

**Dinner for students** will begin with a welcome drink at 6:00 PM at Amaranthen (Rådhuset), followed by dinner at 7:00 PM nearby at Piperska Muren.

**Dinner for teachers** will be on Friday at 6:00 PM at Stora Skuggan, about a 10-minute walk from Aula Magna.

**Name Badges** Pick up your name badge upon registration in Aula Magna. It should be worn at all times — it serves as your ticket for the entire Berzelius Days 2026 event.
